



## Storage Limitation When Creating Disk Groups on Dell™ PowerVault™ 660F and 224F Storage Systems

Dell PowerVault 660F and 224F storage systems have a 2-terabyte (TB) storage limitation when creating disk groups. You must ensure that you do not exceed this limitation when using large hard drives to create a disk group.

When you create a disk group using only 146-GB hard drives, do not select more than 14 hard drives to create the disk group or you will exceed the limitation.

When you use a combination of 36-GB, 73-GB, and 146-GB hard drives in the same disk group, you will usually not exceed the 2-TB limitation. However, you should always calculate the combined storage capacity of all of the selected drives to ensure that you do not exceed the storage limitation.
